

## Day Quest FAQ's

**Can we bring our own food?** Yes, you may bring your own food to Day Quest; however glass containers are not permitted on the premises.

### **What extra costs are there?**

Horseback Riding and Paintball are the only activities that are not included in the admission cost for Day Quest. Horseback Riding is available for \$20 per ride. The use of our Paintball course is included in the admission cost of Day Quest; however you must purchase your paintballs at DRG. Paintballs can be purchased in bags of 500 paintballs for \$20. They may be shared with up to two people. If you pre-register for Paintball when you make your reservation rentals are FREE, otherwise they are available for \$5 per rental. Rentals include goggles, CO2 and marker. You may also want to bring some extra cash for our lunch package, snacks at our Side Track Café, and items in our Doe River Gorge Outfitters stores.

**Are there lockers for our use while we're here?** We're sorry, at this present time we do not have locker facilities. We do have bathroom facilities available for changing.

### **What are the age requirements for the activities?**

Horseback Riding ~ 8 & up

Paintball ~ 10 & up

Triple Zipline ~ 8 & up

**Is it necessary for Families and Groups to pre-register and pre-order meals?** Yes, you do need to *pre-register for Day Quest* and for meals if you plan to have lunch with us. Day Quest is becoming more and more popular and Doe River Gorge is becoming more widely known throughout the area and our region. As popularity continues to grow, so do our Day Quest numbers. Be sure to make your reservations soon to ensure your space at Day Quest! Also, a limited number of meals are available the day of above the number of those that pre-ordered meals.

### **Do children under 18 need to have a parent or guardian with them at Day Quest?**

Yes, all minors must have a parent or guardian present with them at Day Quest. Be sure to have prior parental or legal guardian consent on our *Hold Harmless Agreement Form* before arrival. Minors must be accompanied by adult supervision while at Day Quest.

**What is the program for the day?** Day Quest is simply a day for people in the community to come out and enjoy the beauty of the Gorge, the fun activities that Doe

River Gorge provides, and spend time relaxing with family and friends. There is no set program; you are free to choose from the activities available throughout the day!

**Is overnight lodging available?** Yes, during the late August and September dates we offer a weekend package to groups and families, the *Endless Summer Get-A-Way*.

**Is there a Group Discount?** We offer the lowest possible rates to everyone for Day Quest so that it is affordable to all.

**How much advance notice is required?** Do to increasing popularity of Day Quest, it is suggested to make your reservation as soon as possible to ensure the date you would like to visit is available; especially if you are coming with a sizable group. Reservations are open until the Thursday before each Day Quest or unless a particular Day Quest date becomes full. If a date becomes full it will show as “*FULL*” on the Day Quest calendar on the website.

**During the *Endless Summer Get-A-Way* what activities are available in the evening on Friday and Saturday?** The following activities are available at your leisure throughout the weekend during *Endless Summer Get-A-Way*: sand court volleyball, octaball, ping pong, foosball, disc golf, 9-hole disc golf course, soccer fields, playing field with balls available, hiking in the Gorge (except on the railroad tracks during Day Quest), and fishing (with appropriate permits and own gear). There will also be a community bonfire in the plaza on Saturday evening.
