## Arrival & Departure

*Day Quest* is open from 10:00 am to 4:30 pm. Registration opens at 9:30 am; however activities begin at 10:00 am.

## Fees

*Day Quest* is just \$18 per person; children age 7 & under are FREE. Pre-registration for *Day Quest* is required. A buffet meal is available for \$8; a hot dog kid's meal (11 & under) is available for \$4.00. Pre-registration for Paintball is suggested to guarantee your space; limited availability the day-of. Equipment rental, and paintballs are also available (available space during *Day Quest* is on a first-come, first-served basis). Horseback Rides may be purchased on arrival (first-come, first-served). All lake activities and Unimog rides (military ATV type vehicle) are included in the cost of *Day Quest*. Cash, check, and credit or debit cards are accepted. There is no extra charge for the train ride, but try to get in line early!

**FAMILIES & GROUPS:** The payment amount is based on your estimated number of participants, meals, and paintball pre-registration and is due at the time you make your reservations. You are responsible for at least 80% of the initial number reserved unless you notify us in writing (by email or mail) of changes two weeks prior to arrival. Additions can be made, but please be aware that some dates do fill up. If you need to add one or two that is no problem, more than that please check to see if there is space. **Please collect money before arrival and make one payment for your group.**

## Age Requirements

**All** minors must be accompanied by an adult (18 or older). Participants (or parent/guardian) must fill out and sign a consent form prior to arrival. The minimum age for the aqua mountain is 6 years old. The minimum age is 8 for the zip-line, blob, and horseback riding, and 11 for the deep-water swimming/diving area. Paintball participants must be at least 10 years old. No one under 18 is permitted on the premises without safety-conscious adult supervision. **Adults are responsible for the supervision of their minors.**

If you are unable to attend, please kindly notify us at least two weeks prior to your scheduled arrival to re-schedule a date based on availability this season.

If *Day Quest* is halted for the entire time due to weather, a pass for a future *Day Quest* or a full refund will be given at the request of the attendee.

#### From Roanoke, VA (south bound):

- ◆ Take I-81 South to Route 394 East (Exit 69 Blountville / Bristol Speedway).
- ◆ From Exit 69 go 5 ½ miles and turn right onto Hwy 11E/19W toward Johnson City.
- ◆ Continue 3 ½ miles to Hwy 19E.
- ◆ Turn left onto 19E South to Elizabethton.
- ◆ Continue south on 19E for 9 miles to traffic light on edge of Elizabethton (Food City).
- ◆ You are now exactly 6 miles from us.
- ◆ After you have gone 5 miles, you will see a Shell station and Subway on your left.

#### From Nashville, TN (northeast bound):

- ◆ Take I-40 East to Knoxville, TN.
- ◆ Continue on I-40 approx 30 miles to I-81.
- ◆ Take I-81 North approx 57 miles to Exit #57 A. This exits onto I-26 South towards Johnson City.
- ◆ Go approx 15 miles to Exit #24 Hwy 67.
- ◆ At end of ramp, turn right on 67 east and stay on 67 through Elizabethton.
- ◆ Turn right onto 19E South (at Food City).
- ◆ You are now exactly 6 miles from us.
- ◆ After you have gone 5 miles, you will see a Shell station and Subway on your left.

#### From Asheville, NC (northeast bound):

- ◆ Take I-26 North (formerly 23 North not Bus. 23) to TN state line near Erwin, TN.
- ◆ Go approx 15 miles north of Erwin to Exit #24 Hwy 67.
- ◆ At end of ramp, turn right on 67 east and stay on 67 through Elizabethton.
- ◆ Turn right onto 19E South (at Food City).
- ◆ You are now exactly 6 miles from us.
- ◆ After you have gone 5 miles, you will see a Shell station and Subway on your left.

#### From Boone, NC (northwest bound):

- ◆ Take Hwy 321 into TN through Butler and past Watauga Lake.
- ◆ Continue to the stop sign in Hampton.
- ◆ Turn left onto 19E South (Shell and Subway on left).

*Continued*

- ◆ Continue straight for 1 mile then left on Doe River Gorge Rd on the left.
- ◆ Slow down as you pass a Sawmill on the left and make an immediate left turn onto Doe River Gorge Road (between the sawmill and a house).
- ◆ If you have gone more than one mile past the Shell station and Subway, you've missed us.
